Memory Work for Q2, Week 1

<u>Preposition</u> – A preposition is a word used with a noun or pronoun to show place, position, time, or means.

Question: To find the preposition, say the preposition word and ask WHAT or WHOM.

Label: P

Object of the Preposition – The object of the preposition is the noun or pronoun following the preposition.

Question: To find an object of the preposition, say the preposition and ask WHAT or WHOM.

Label: **OP**

<u>Prepositional Phrase</u> – A prepositional phrase starts with a preposition and ends with the object of the preposition.

Label: (Place parentheses around prepositional phrases.)

Note: Prepositional phrases can be adverbial (modifies a verb, adverb, or adjective) or adjectival (modifies a noun or pronoun).
