And the great thing about Core A is that this particular assignment is just a completion assignment! So what does that mean?? As long as you have all the required elements, you get an A on the assignment regardless of how well you present your information. This is just for practice after all ☺

For this presentation, you need to choose a missionary that you want to do a little bit of research on and share about with the class. You cannot pick Jim Elliot, but anyone else is fair game! I've included a list of possible ones below.

Assignment Requirements:

- Basic information about the missionary – name, date of birth/death and location, anything else you think is important (siblings, married, children, etc.)
- What inspired them to become a missionary? Was there a specific moment or story?
- Where did they go? A specific region, country, people group, etc?
- What did they do there? How did they serve?
- Any other interesting stories or facts about their life that you would like to include!
- This is a mini presentation. So don't expect to present for more than 5 minutes. You don't even have to present that long, but I didn't want anyone getting worried or overwhelmed about length.
- HOW you present is up to you! You can write your information as a report and read it, you can create a PowerPoint and email it to me, you can create a posterboard, etc. Whatever you want, just let me know! ☺
