

Core A Comp & Lit | Narrative Paragraphs

The purpose of narrative writing is to tell a story, and it is one of four classical ways that writers present information. Narratives enable people to express and record their life stories, and to share their knowledge and their values to a broader audience.

Your assignment is to write a journal entry from the perspective of Annie Sullivan, Kate Keller, Captain Keller, or James Keller. Pick a specific scene from Act 2 and tell it from your chosen character's perspective. Include the events that took place and their thoughts and reaction to the event. Before you write your journal entry, you should plot out your narrative on a blank story chart, showing the sequence of events that will occur in your story. Your entry should be at least 2 paragraphs in length, with each paragraph consisting of at least 6 sentences. Please use the following checklist as a guide for the assignment requirements:

- MLA format (header, double space, size 12 Times New Roman, etc.)
- A clear chronological order with a beginning, middle, and end to the story
- Strong verbs
- Good transitions between sentences
- At least 3 different sentence openers per paragraph
- Appeals to some of the five senses: taste, touch, sight, sound, smell
- Quality adverbs and adjectives
- No contractions
- Completed story chart stapled to the back of your paragraphs.
- Submit your paragraphs to Turnitin.com
